

Agreement Form -Puppy Love Daycare LLC

This is an Agreement between Puppy Love Daycare LLC (hereinafter called "PLD") and the pet owner whose signature appears below (hereinafter called "Owner").

1. All dogs must pass the PLD behavior assessment for enrollment. All dogs must be non-aggressive and not food or toy protective. *Owners will need to certify that their dog(s) have not harmed or shown any aggressive or threatening behavior towards any person or any other dogs. Please remember that your pet will be spending time with other dogs and that their safety and health is our main priority. Although it is supervised play, your pet still might acquire an occasional nip or scratch.*
2. PLD has the right to refuse service at any time if it is determined that daycare, or other, are deemed inappropriate for the dog, whether temporary or permanent.
3. Pads on paws may initially become sensitive, or bothered until the dog becomes used to playing on different surfaces. There are inherent risks of illness or injury when dealing with animals. Such risks include, but are not limited to, problems resulting from rough play, food scraps found outdoors and kennel cough (doggie colds).
4. PLD will provide quality and reasonable care for dogs left in its care, but cannot provide constant observation of every dog.
5. All dogs must be spayed or neutered unless 6 months or younger. All dogs must have up-to-date vaccinations. Owners must submit verification that their dogs have current on DHLPP, Rabies and Kennel Cough vaccinations.
6. All dogs that arrive with fleas and/or other parasites will be bathed and quarantined. The Owner is responsible for any expenses incurred for such reasons.
7. All dogs must be in good health. Owners will need to certify that their dogs are in good health and have been free from any condition that could potentially jeopardize other dogs. *Dogs who have been ill with a communicable condition in the last 30 days will require veterinarian certification of health to be admitted or readmitted.*
8. Quick release collars are required with nametags.
9. Dogs may be photographed, videotaped, and/or used in any media or advertising without prior approval by owner.
10. Applicable fees are due and payable at the end of each day. Cash, check or MasterCard/Visa are accepted. Discounted packages are provided only if they are paid in advance. Pre-paid packages are non-refundable and expire 3 months from purchase date. See rate card at PLD offices for details.
11. Rates and fees are subject to change.
12. If the pet becomes ill or if the state of the pet's health otherwise requires professional attention, PLD will attempt to contact Owner in order to discuss treatment of the dog and/or call your veterinarian. PLD, in its sole discretion, may engage the services of a veterinarian or administer medicine or give other requisite attention to the pet, and the expenses thereof shall be paid by Owner.
13. Hours of operation for day care are Monday through Friday from 7:30 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. Drop off and pick up any time during these hours. *Early drop-off (before 7:30am) or Late pick-up (after 6pm) charge of \$1.00 per minute.* Reservations are required. Cancellations not made by 5:30 p.m. one business day prior ***to the scheduled day care day will be charged full fees and invoiced to the Owner.***
14. The owner is responsible for any harm caused by his/her dog while attending PLD. The owner shall indemnify PLD against any claims made against the business or losses or damages of any kind suffered by PLD as a result of the owner's failure to inform PLD of any pre-existing condition the dog may have (such as illness or aggression problems.)
15. The owners agrees that PLD will not be liable for problems, damage, or injury caused by the dog provided reasonable care and precautions are followed by day care staff. The owner releases PLD of any liability arising from the dog's attendance and participation at the daycare. The owner understands that the daycare is a place where animals co-mingle in groups. The owner understands that the dog may be placed in a crate for "time outs", for overnight care or if injured. The owner understands that the dog may experience minor cuts, scratches, and abrasions due to the nature of dog play. Daycare staff may or may not notify the owner immediately. If the injury is serious, the owner will be notified immediately.
16. If Owner does not pick up the pet, or make contact with PLD, within 5 calendar days after the day the pet was due to be picked up, the pet shall be deemed to be abandoned, and necessary steps will be taken to turn the pet over to the proper authorities.
17. This Agreement contains the entire agreement between the parties. All terms and conditions of this Contract shall be binding on the heirs, administrators, personal representatives and assigns of Owner and PLD.
